Dear Alex,

We met with the client at the end of last week who confirmed that the Ceanothus was definitely of the evergreen type. We were provided with photographs taken in November (several years apart) showing the shrub in full leaf while surrounding tree have lost or are loosing their foliage.

We have therefore filled the form which you issued us a few weeks ago describing the tree as dying. We are also including the evergreen photos and one photos of the defoliated tree taken in January.

When we discussed this on the phone, you mentioned the fact that, if the tree was dying, the application would be a "formality". Our client is quite keen for the contractors to carry out clearance as soon as possible so that basic landscaping operations (such as ground preparation and grading) can start, so I would be grateful if you could give me an idea of the time it might take to process this application.
