Reason(s) for Refusal

1 The proposed roof extension, by reason of its scale, design, and extent of glazing, would be detrimental to the appearance of the building and character and



appearance of the conservation area contrary to policies B1 (General design principles), B3 (Alterations and extensions) and B7 (Conservation areas) of the London Borough of Camden Replacement Unitary Development Plan 2006.

Informative(s):

1 The proposed french doors to the rear first floor terrace, and the replacement conservatory, are considered to be acceptable and would be recommended for approval if a separate application was submitted to the Council.
