NOTES OF OBJECTION TO A PLANNING APPLICATION

HOW DOES THIS AFFECT YOU?

Camden Council has received a planning application for the development of the site. The Council is now considering the application and will decide whether to grant or refuse the application. You have the right to object to the application if you think it will affect you in a way that is not in the public interest. You should submit your objection to the Council as soon as possible, so that it can be taken into account when the Council makes its decision. Your objection should be in writing and should state the reasons why you think the application will affect you. You should also state what you think the Council should do about the application. You can submit your objection to the Council by email, by post or by hand. The Council will consider all objections and will decide whether to grant or refuse the application. If the Council grants the application, you will have the right to appeal the Council's decision to the Planning Inspectorate. If the Council refuses the application, you will not have the right to appeal. The Council will send you a letter telling you the reasons for its decision and what you can do if you are not happy with the decision.
