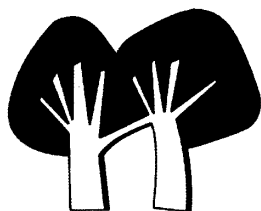

26 Harley Road, NW3 3BN, 5-Day Notice

Following our telephone conversation this morning and site meeting of 27/1/10, write to notify you of my client's wish to fell within 5 days, three poplar trees at the above address, listed as T2, 3 & 5 in our planning report: HV-HRL-AIA-01. As you saw, the trees, which stand on the roadside are in poor condition, exhibiting varying numbers of brackets of the decay fungus, *Rigidoporus* on their stems. The trees are dangerous and my client requests that they be considered exempt from conservation area protection by virtue of section 198(6)(a) of the 1990 Town & Country Planning Act. The client will submit a replacement planting plan for the front in due course, but initial recommendations are for 3 x English oak as min. 10-12cm girth stock.

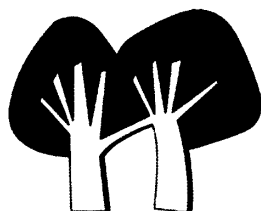
