REAR GARDEN: 1 X Eucalyptus - Cut down to ground level.

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 16 December 2009 and decided to **OBJECT** for the following reasons:

Reasons for objection:

- 1 This tree is visible from the public realm, it is considered to provide a high level of visual amenity within the street scene and to make a positive contribution to the character of this part of the conservation area. The tree is an evergreen which is considered to enhance the visual amenity value of the tree as it provides year round colour. Although the tree has been reduced in the past it is still considered to have an attractive shape.


No valid reasons for removing the tree or supporting documents/evidence that the tree is causing damage or is dead/dying/dangerous have been submitted with the application.
