The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

The proposed tree house, by reason of its bulk, height and location, would be detrimental to the character and appearance of the rear garden and the wider Redington/Frognal Conservation Area contrary to policies B1 (General design principles), B3 (Alterations and extensions) and B7 (Conservation areas) of the London Borough of Camden Replacement Unitary Development Plan 2006.



The proposed tree house, by reason of its location and height, would result in unreasonable overlooking of the neighbouring property at No. 41 Hollycroft Avenue, to the detriment of the amenites of the occupants in terms of loss of privacy contrary to policy SD6 (Amenity for occupiers and neighbours) of the London Borough of Camden Replacement Unitary Development Plan 2006.
