Reason(s) for Refusal

1 The proposed demolition of 48 Queens Grove, in the absence of sufficient justification in line with the demolition tests contained within Planning Policy Guidance 15: Planning and the Historic Environment, would be detrimental to the



character and appearance of the St John's Wood Conservation Area, contrary to policy B7 (Conservation areas) of the London Borough of Camden Replacement Unitary Development Plan 2006.

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
