Site Description

No. 14 is occupied by the Department of Anthropology and No. 16 the School of Slavonic and Eastern European Studies. Both form part of the University of London campus. The buildings front the west side of Taviton Street

Assessment

This is part of a programme for the introduction of new corporate signage for buildings occupied by University College London.

No. 14 Taviton Street School of Anthropology

A wall mounted on one side of the entrance (proposed 1)

A wall mounted sign on a low front boundary wall indicating ramp access (proposed 2)

A railing mounted sign to one side of the entrance providing instructions for the push-bell entry system (proposed 3).

No. 16 Taviton Street (SSEES)

A new wall mounted sign either side of the entrance.

Material, detailed design and method of fixing

All are aluminium of a standard design with a recessed element denoting UCL at the base in a different colour. The typeface is suitably small and detailed design and colour scheme was agreed during pre-application meetings with the Council's Conservation and Design Officers.

There would be 6 bolt fixings per sign through a wall fixing frame.

None of the signs would be illuminated.

It is considered that the signs successfully balance the needs of improved legibility within the UCL area whilst preserving the character and appearance of the Bloomsbury Conservation Area. The proposal is therefore considered acceptable.
