This morning I had a meeting with Kevin Fisher from the London Borough of Camden Tree Department. We discussed matters regarding the existing trees within the front garden area.

The existing Elder tree in the corner adjacent to the refuse store can be removed. The removal of this tree will also be included as part of the Planning Application for the proposed works.

Kevin Fisher stated that part of the condition for removing the existing Elder tree is that it should be replaced with a Hawthorn tree located on the other side of the path. He has another reason for locating the Hawthorn tree in this position. The existing large tree in front of the bay windows is in poor condition and Kevin Fisher mentioned that this tree will eventually have to be removed. The new Hawthorn tree will eventually provide some form of screening to the bay windows.

I have included a reduced plan to clarify the proposal for the trees.

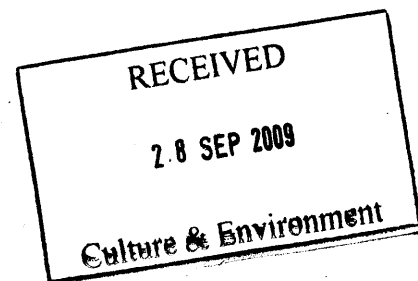
