

Personal Testing

The second main activity is personal testing. This is done by AOB Compaz and involves more than 18,000 clients. Testing is done by means of educational programmes, disability assessment, immigration tests and competencies of both the employed and the unemployed.

Immigration Services

The third activity is immigration services for immigrants by Capabel. The services are language education, activities in order to learn about society and reintegration to work. Yearly, about 4,500 customers are involved in a Capabel programme.

Healthcare

In the field of healthcare two companies are active within the holding. One is active in mental healthcare. It operates countrywide under Dutch law for medical institutions. The company was newly established in 2005 and has grown to about 3,500 clients yearly. It operates under the name Max Ernst. The second company in healthcare operates for clients with psychological problems offering them counselling and training. It operates under the name Jan Arends.

Debt Counselling

Recently Calder acquired debt-counselling organisation Westerbeek. Its main services are to arrange clients' financial affairs and regulate their debts.
