DESIGN AND ACCESS STATEMENT SEPTEMBER 2009 QCCA - APPLICATION FOR NEW CHANGING ROOMS AND SHOWERS

1.0 THE PROCESS - ASSESSMENT

1.1 Physical Context

The Queen's Crescent Community Centre is located in the heart of Gospel Oak just to the north of Queens Crescent. There are sports playground adjacent.

1.2 Social and economic context

New changing rooms and associated facilities will allow the centre to run organised sports classes and fixtures in the sports pitches.

1.3 Planning policy

This is not a conservation area. The council is committed to organised sports provision

6.0 LAYOUT

Refer to drawings. Access is from the outside of the centre. A small plant room will be accessed from within Queens Crescent community centre.

7.0 SCALE

This is a small structure which will be tagged on to the existing community centre.

8.0 LANDSCAPING

The existing planting is to be retained at the front of the centre.

9.0 APPEARANCE

The proposed building will be clad in yellow brickwork to match the existing building. The roof has been pitched to avoid rubbish collecting there from items dropped from above.

10.0 ACCESS

Disabled facilities are provided in the community centre and are therefore not required in this additional structure.
