Site Safety

All operatives, including subcontractors, working on site will be made aware of the Health and Safety risk assessments of Skyline Roofing Kingston. Instructions will be given regarding specific site conditions and procedures which must be adhered to.

Hard hats, high visibility jackets and safety footwear must be worn at all times where instructed or signed on site. This will generally be during the initial start up of the project.

All powered hand tools will be 110v or battery operated.

The relevant test certificates and identification numbers of any hired in plant will be submitted to SITE SUPERVISOR prior to use on site.
