Removal of two willow trees on the eastern boundary of the Camley Street Natural Park, as shown on submitted drawing 280_04_07_003. These trees overhang the adjacent site, which is the subject of a simultaneous application for the development of a new Gas Governor, and pose a security risk for the completed development. Their removal is also necessary for access to the western boundary of the adjacent site in order to construct a perimeter wall. Further details regarding the removal of the trees and the proposed Gas Governor development are provided in the Submission Statement for the application for approval of details relating to the same.
