## Holborn Satellite Compound Traffic Management Plan – Amendment A

This Traffic Management Plan outlines how disruptions to traffic caused by construction traffic are to be effectively managed with the objective of minimising traffic disruption and avoiding dangerous situations for pedestrians and other road users.
