Proposal:

Change of use of the ground floor of no. 73 from retail shop (Class A1) to restaurant (Class A3) as an extension to the existing restaurant at nos. 75-77 Marchmont Street, to provide a single planning unit, together with the installation of a replacement shopfront and awning over the frontage of nos. 73-77 Marchmont Street.

1 The development hereby permitted must be begun not later than the end of three years from the date of this permission.

Reason: In order to comply with the provisions of Section 91 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended).

2 All new external work shall be carried out in materials that resemble, as closely as possible, in colour and texture those of the existing building, unless otherwise specified in the approved application.

Reason: To safeguard the appearance of the premises and the character of the immediate area in accordance with the requirements of policies S1/S2 and B1 and B7 of the London Borough of Camden Replacement Unitary Development Plan 2006.

3 Before the development commences, details of the location, design and method of waste storage and removal (including recycled materials) shall be submitted to and approved by the Council and the approved facility shall therefore be provided prior to the first occupation of number 73 as A3 floorspace and permanently maintained and retained thereafter.

Reason: To safeguard the amenities of the adjoining premises and the area generally in accordance with the requirements of policies SD6, SD7B, SD8, Appendix 1 and R1B/R2/R3 of the London Borough of Camden Replacement Unitary Development Plan 2006.

4 The use hereby permitted shall not be carried out outside the following times 09:00am to 11:30pm Mondays to Fridays and 09:00am to 11:30pm Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays.

Reason: To safeguard the amenities of the adjoining premises and the area generally in accordance with the requirements of policies SD6 and R1B/R2/R3 of the London Borough of Camden Replacement Unitary Development Plan 2006.
