The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

The proposed kiosk, by reason of its siting, size and design, would result in visual clutter harmful to the appearance of the adjoining building at 47 New Oxford Street, to the character and appearance of the streetscene and Bloomsbury Conservation Area and to the setting of surrounding listed buildings, contrary to policies B1



- (General design principles), B6 (Listed buildings) and B7 (Conservation areas) of the London Borough of Camden Replacement Unitary Development Plan 2006.
- The proposed kiosk, by reason of its siting and size, would result in unnecessary street clutter which would harm pedestrian access, safety and amenity and would harm the character and appearance of the street environment, contrary to policies T1 (Sustainable transport), T3 (Pedestrians and cycling) and T12 (Works affecting highways) of the London Borough of Camden Replacement Unitary Development Plan 2006.
