#### **Assessment**

#### Proposal:

It is proposed to discharge conditions 2 and 3 of planning permission granted on appeal. The Inspector considered that the ATM was acceptable in principle subject to additional security measures to ensure community safety was maintained.

## Assessment:

Details submitted show a light and CCTV camera. The light is a simple box-like light fitting placed above the shop fascia sign to illuminate the area round the ATM below; the light is small and discreet and similar in size and appearance to the burglar alarm existing above the fascia on its right hand side. The camera is a modern semi-spherical feature to be attached on the left side of the fascia on the corbel bracket. Again it is small and discreet and does not add to visual clutter on this shopfront or building which already has 2 alarms and spotlights. Both features as proposed are appropriate in size, position and detailing to the building, which is not significant in the streetscape and are considered to preserve the character of the conservation area. The features as recommended by the Inspector are sufficient to maintain and enhance community safety in the area.

It is recommended that the details are approved.
