1	Ash	It is a maturing tree, located to the side of the new health centre within a small formal garden area on the southern side of the property. It is about 12m in height with a healthy but slightly asymmetrical crown spreading towards the neighbour's garden to the south. Although the tree is located within the property and only partly visible from the roadside, it is visible to users of the health centre.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reduce longest side branches where they overhang the neighbours garden by up to 2m to provide a balanced crown • Crown clean 	<p>The crown has been slightly suppressed on its northern side, due to the adjacent ash and has extended growth on its southern side as a result. Therefore, some remedial pruning is recommended to balance the crown and reduce overhanging branches from the neighbouring property. There is also one small broken branch still attached to the stem overhanging the car park which is likely to break off completely in the short term. This should be removed as soon as practicably possible.</p> <p>In the context of the proximity to the well used areas beneath the canopy, it would seem reasonable to do some remedial pruning works to the tree to establish acceptable levels of risk.</p>
2	Ash	It is a maturing tree, partly suppressed by tree 1 with some minor dead wood throughout the crown. The area beneath the tree is formal seating within a small garden. Although the tree is located within the property and is hardly visible from the roadside, it is visible to users of the health centre	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Crown clean 	<p>In the context of the proximity to the well used areas beneath the canopy, it would seem reasonable to do some remedial pruning works to the tree to establish acceptable levels of risk.</p>
