



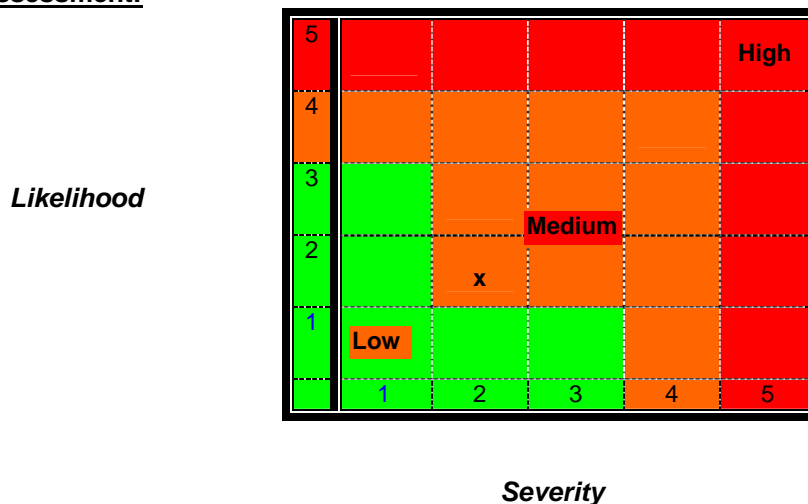

Hazards:

Falls from Height & Falling Objects – Containment or tools knocked off ladders or platforms
Head & Eye & Hand Injuries – Resulting from shards from containment or open bladed knives
Manual Handling & Posture – Overreaching as per Manual Handling RA 07
Noise & Vibration – Use of power tools as per RA 08
Crushing & Trapping – As per the MEWP RA01 & Towers & Scaffolds RA 04

General Control Measures:

1. Electra-Net UK Limited will liaise with the SPM and communication will be maintained at all times during the containment installation period.
2. The working area will be cordoned off and suitable signs posted to avoid injuries to third parties.
3. The Electra-Net UK Limited Site Lead Engineers will ensure that access equipment is erected, dismantled and inspected in accordance with the Construction (working places) Regulations and the Suppliers guidance note, and the access equipment user will be a fully trained user.



Specific Control Measures:-

1. If hazardous substances are used a COSHH assessment will be required.
2. Where there is extensive drilling and cutting there may be a need for a noise assessment this will be assessed by Electra-Net UK Limited prior to installation.
3. A vacuum cleaner is to be used at the point of drilling in order to reduce dust.
4. The engineers will be issued correct PPE and it will be worn at all times.
5. An exclusion zone will be established where practicable to prevent public access in to the working area.
