thanks for sending the additional details through on Friday. On the basis of the information submitted to date, C&UD accept the latest iteration of the proposed terrace guarding for Southampton Row - ie. a glass balustrade reduced in height by a further 100mm (as suggested in your email below) and set back 750mm from the face of the stonework.

My colleague Joanna has been briefed on this matter should you need to discuss anything further with her.

Hi Louise,

The attached scan showing the glass is of an earlier detail indicating the glass guarding.

The stone detail has been amended since this time and is indicated on the other attachment rev F but the relationship is very similar in terms of the set back of the glass from the outer face of stone.

We would be able to reduce the guarding height indicated on the glass details by 100mm.

Hope this is clear to follow.
