TREE WORK APPLICATION

<u>SPECIES</u>	<u>WORK PROPOSED</u>
2 Cherry x 1 (CA/N) (<i>Prunus spp</i>)	Clean out crown, remove dead wood.
4 Cherry x 3 (CA/N) (<i>Prunus spp</i>)	Middle tree, poor and rocking on root plate. Suggest: Remove with roots. Replace with new 2.5 - 3m Cherry.
6 Sycamore x 1 (CA/N) (<i>Acer pseudoplatanus</i>)	Young, self-seeded tree, poor condition. In order to pre-empt future problems: fell to ground level. Grind down stump.
7 Evergreen Oak x 1 (CA/N) (<i>Quercus ilex</i>)	Lift and prune back from building, remove adjacent self-seeded Ash sapling.
8 Mulberry x 1 (CA/N)	Very mature, very poor, split fork. Suggest: Thin branch ends by 25-30% to lessen weight and stress. Clean out crown, remove dead wood and lift and balance.
9 Lime x 1 (CA/N) (<i>Tilia spp</i>)	Hack job by neighbours has left a one sided tree. Suggest: Remove stumped branches, prune back and re-shape as possible remainder of tree. Clear building, clean out crown.
10 Sycamore x 1 (CA/N) (<i>Acer pseudoplatanus</i>)	Prune back from building by 1-2m.

- 12 Tree of Heaven x 1 (*Ailanthus altissima*)

Reduce and re-shape 20-25% all round to contain and balance and make safe. Clean out crown, remove dead wood.

- 13 Tree of Heaven x 1 (*Ailanthus altissima*)

Reduce and re-shape 20-25% all round to contain and balance and make safe. Clean out crown, remove dead wood.

- 14 Yew Common x 2 (*Taxus baccata*)

Lift and prune back over pavement and road by 2m to clear statutory height and improve pedestrian access.

- 15 Sycamore x 1 (*Acer pseudoplatanus*)

Prominent from location. Very large, mature tree. Clean out crown, remove dead wood, weak, suppressed branches to pre-empt branch shedding.

- 16 Lime x 1 (*Tilia spp*)

Very large, mature tree. Clean out crown, remove dead wood, weak, suppressed branches to pre-empt branch shedding.

- 17 Tree of Heaven x 1 (*Ailanthus altissima*)

Very large, mature tree, straggly crown, reduce and re-shape 15-20% all round to contain balance and counter limb shedding potential. Clean out crown and remove dead wood.

- 18 Lombardy Poplar x 1 (*Populus nigra 'Italica'*)

Remove larger re-growth to previous pruning points, retain smaller growth for crown continuity, clean out crown, remove dead wood and suckers.

- 19 False Acacia x 1 (*Robinia pseudoacacia*)

Very, large, mature tree. Clean out crown, remove dead wood, weak, suppressed branches and suckers.

- 20 Lime x 1 (*Tilia spp*)

Clean out crown, remove dead wood.

- 21 Ash x 1 (*Fraxinus excelsior*)

Remove Ivy, reduce and re-shape crown to contain and balance. Clean out crown.

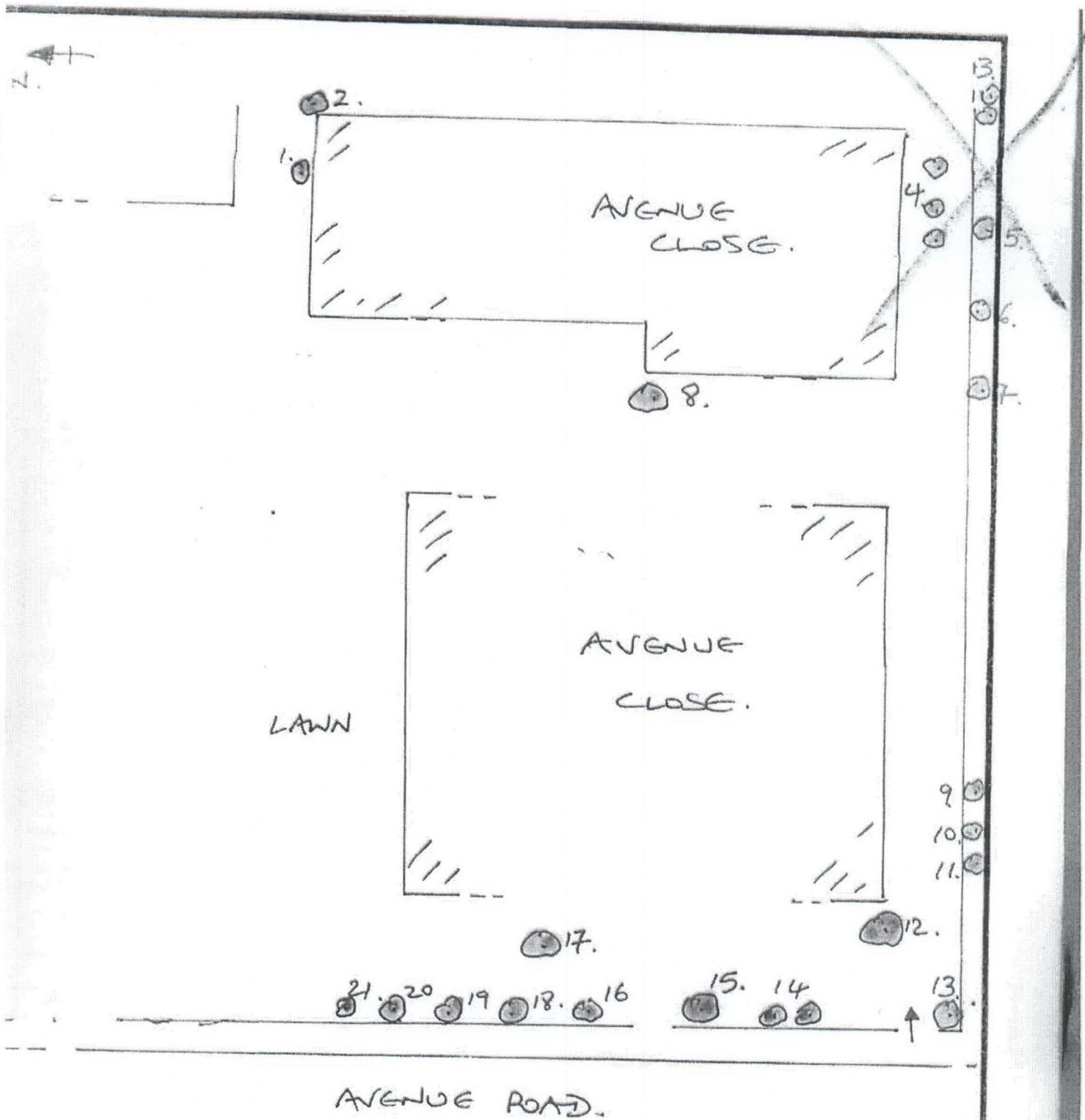
