The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

1 The single storey extension (conservatory), by reason of its width, depth, appearance and detailed design is not considered to be either of a high standard of design or to respect the character and appearance of the Conservation Area contrary to Policy B1 "General Design", B3 "Alterations and Extensions" and B7 "Conservation Areas" of the London Borough of Camden Replacement UDP 2006,

2 The single storey extension (conservatory) by reason of its width and depth is considered to encroach on the amenity of the occupiers of the basement flat of no. 10 Chalcot Gardens in terms of loss of privacy and outlook and at the upper ground floor level of no. 9 in terms of light pollution contrary to policies SD6 "Amenity for occupier and Neighbours" of the London Borough of Camden Unitary Development Plan.
