#### **Assessment**

Advertisement consent is sought for the retention of a flag pole and flag as part of a national quality standard for parks, run by The Civic Trust. The flag has been awarded to the park as part of a scheme that acknowledges quality parks and green spaces.

The green flag is to be located in the centre of the open space in the playground area adjacent to a wooden shed. The flag is to advertise the 'Green Flag' status of the park. The flag pole measures approximately 4.5m high. The flag measures 0.87m wide, 1.78m high and 0.05m deep. The flag is green with white text, with a motif of a tree and people. The maximum height of any of the individual letters or symbols will be vill be 790mm.

The green flag would be visible from wider areas of the open space and Prince of Wales Road. The flag would be obscured slightly from Talacre Road by vegetation on the edge of the park. The proposed green flag and pole are considered to be of an appropriate scale and would not be an unduly dominant feature in the park. It is considered the flag will blend with the environment of the open space and constitutes a positive feature for the park and the wider area.

It is considered that the proposed flag is acceptable and would not have a detrimental impact on the visual amenity if the open space or the wider Conservation Area.

**Recommendation:** Grant advertisement consent.

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
