The tree surgeon pollarded the two elm trees in our rear garden as discussed with you and approved.

The surgeon confirmed that both trees have extensive rot in their topmost sections.

He recommended and we hereby request permission to reduce both tree heights by approximately 3 to 4 m from their current height of approximately 9 metres.

This height reduction will ensure a longer life for the trees by reducing their centre of gravity and thereby increasing their stability currently much reduced by the extensive rot in the topmost sections.

Please find enclosed some photographs taken during the tree surgeons visit including one taken by the tree surgeon of the rot from above the tree. The rot in the tree on the left in the photo marked Figure A is more extensive than the tree

on its right in the photograph and may need to be cut a bit lower than the other tree.

Please provide permission which will allow us to reduce those tree heights in the Spring of 2010. We do not want to cut the trees further this late in the growing season and would therefore request permission to have the cutting done in Spring 2010.


