In the context of the Mayor's transport policy, Transport for London (TfL) has been tasked with implementing a Cycle Hire Scheme in London. The target date for the scheme coming into use is May 2010, subject to the grant of the necessary consents.

TfL has consulted extensively with Royal Parks and the London boroughs hosting the scheme to select appropriate sites and shape the design of the docking stations. TfL has also worked closely with English Heritage and Design for London to come up with a design appropriate for London. Public notification and consultation through forums and Drop-in Centres has commenced.

This planning application is for the installation on the above site of a docking station. A docking station comprises the terminal and docking points at one site. Users will hire a bicycle from the docking station, use it as desired and return it to either the same or another docking station. The terminal is required to secure and release the bicycles, for payment of subscription fees and user tariffs and to provide information about the area including the location of other docking stations and way-finding mapping (which has deemed advertising consent).
