## SCHEDULE

Date of Original Application : 3rd July 1991

Address : Templar House, 81 - 87 High Holborn, WC1

Proposal : The display of two internally illuminated box signs located on stonework on either side of recessed entrance doorway, each measuring 2,680mm x 800mm x 75mm, as shown on drawing numbers 07/1015/AA/(9)/01 and 07/1015/AL/(0)/02 A and two colour photocopied photos.

## Reason(s) for Refusal:

- 01 The proposed signs are considered to be visually detrimental to the appearance of the building, by virtue of their size and position on the entrance doorway stone pilasters, covering the original square stone panels which are integral to the original building design.
