SIR,

THE LONDON BUILDING ACT, 1930.

Frognaal Rise and Windmill Hill, Hampstead.

With reference to your application dated **25th November**, 1936, I have been directed to intimate to you the Council's decision, which is as follows:—

That consent be given under section **79** of the London Building Act, 1930, but in no way otherwise than under such section, to the erection of **jalousies**, in deal, to the bedroom windows to a building upon a site abutting upon **Frognaal Rise and Windmill Hill, Hampstead**,

as shown on the plan (No.169,061) as amended in red, submitted in connection with the application of **Mr. A. Kirkham**, on behalf of ~~M~~ subject to the following conditions:—

(1) that the work shall be commenced within six months and completed within eighteen months from the **1st day of January**, 1937;

(2) that the whole of the work, and any additional work the district surveyor may require for the purpose of securing stability, shall be executed to his satisfaction; and

(3) that the **jalousies** shall be otherwise erected and retained without any addition thereto and in exact accordance with the application for the consent and the said plan and particulars submitted in connection with such application.
