Your application for planning permission dated 16th December 1988

If by 17th February 1989 you have not received notice of the Council's
decision (and you have not agreed in writing that the period within
which the decision shall be given may be extended) you may appeal to
the Secretary of State for the Environment in accordance with sections
36 and 37 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 by notice sent
within six months from that date (unless the application has already
been referred by this authority to the Secretary of State). In rare
cases the Council may refer applications to the Secretary of State for
his decision, and in such an event you would be informed immediately.

Appeals must be made to the Secretary of State for the Environment,
Tollgate House, Houlton Street, Bristol BS2 9DJ on a form which is
available from that Department.

I also acknowledge receipt of £ 66 as payment of the required fee.

Where payment of an appropriate fee is made by cheque which is
subsequently dishonoured, the application will be treated as invalid
and the statutory eight week period suspended until the fee has been
paid.

NOTE to Applicants: at the present time the Area Team dealing with
