retained and protected from damage to the satisfaction of the Council for a period of at least 12 months following the completion of the development hereby approved, or such longer period as may be required under Sections 198 and 211 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990. Any trees removed without the Council's consent or dying or being severely damaged or becoming seriously diseased during that period shall be replaced as soon as is reasonably possible and, in any case, by not later than the end of the following planting season, with trees of such size and species and in such positions as may be agreed with the Council, without prejudice to any further action the Council may consider appropriate to secure the protection of existing trees.

Reason(s) for Additional Condition(s):

- O1 To ensure that the external appearance of the building will be satisfactory.
- 02 To ensure that the Council may be satisfied that the development will not have an adverse effect on existing trees and in order to maintain the character and amenities of the area.
