Proposal :

Provision of four carparking spaces, as shown on plan numbers 217/2 and 3.

The Council has considered your application and decided to refuse permission for the following reason(s):

Reasons for Refusal

- The proposal fails to comply with the Council's standards for crossover widths and so would be detrimental to local pedestrian safety and, by reason of the close proximity of a traffic island to the crossover, the proposal would be harmful to vehicular safety.
- The proposal is considered by reason of the appearance of the forecourt and the detailed design of the pier lights, to be detrimental to local visual amenity and therefore fails to preserve or enhance the character or appearance of this part of the Conservation Area.
