Proposal:

Alteration of rear window at second floor level to make French door and erection of balcony to rear window, as shown on drawings DWP/2/001 and 002.

The Council has considered your application and decided to refuse permission for the following reason(s):

Reasons for Refusal

- The proposed balcony would be contrary to the Council's policy for the control of alterations within the Fitzjohns/ Netherhall Conservation Area. It would have a detrimental effect on the appearance of the building and on the character and appearance of the Conservation Area.
- The proposal would result in unacceptable overlooking of the gardens to the rear.
