Reason(s) for Refusal:

- 01 The proposal would in effect create a roof top terrace which would result in an unacceptable loss of privacy of and overlooking to private gardens and other residential properties to the rear.
- 02 The railings are an unacceptable and uncharacteristic alteration to a building in a conservation area and which would neither preserve or enhance the character or appearance of the conservation area.
