## TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, 1947

### Permission for Development (Conditional)

Your particular attention is drawn to the provisions of the London Building Acts, 1939 and the by-laws in force thereunder which must be complied with to the satisfaction of the District Surveyor.

I would also remind you that the Council's permission does not modify or affect any personal or restrictive covenants applying to the land or the rights of any person entitled to the benefits thereof.
