TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, 1947 Refusal of permission to develop

Development : **The erection of a building on the sites of Nos. 53 and 60, Heloise Park Gardens, Hampstead, for use as headquarters of the British Legion (Hampstead Branch).**

Reasons for refusal : **The use does not accord with the Council's Development Plan in which this area is allocated for residential purposes and the proposed use is considered to be inappropriate having regard to the residential occupation of the area.**
