TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, 1932.
TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (GENERAL INTERIM
DEVELOPMENT) ORDER, 1933.

With reference to your application dated 16th January, 1937,

I am directed to inform you that the Council, in pursuance of its powers under the above-named Order, hereby permits you to convert into three self-contained flats the premise known as 257, Goldhurst Terrace, Hampstead,

in accordance with the plan 8265 (Registered No. 31700) submitted with

the application subject to (1) compliance with the provisions of the London Building Act, 1930, where they are not inconsistent with this consent; and (2) the sanitary arrangements and those for the storage and removal of dust being to the satisfaction of the Hampstead Metropolitan Borough Council.

The permission is given subject also to due compliance with any local Acts, regulations, building byelaws and general statutory provisions in force in the area and nothing herein shall be regarded as dispensing with such compliance or be deemed to be a consent by the Council thereunder.

I would also remind you that the Council's permission does not modify or affect any personal or restrictive covenants applying to the land or the rights of any person entitled to the benefit thereof.
