Reason(s) for Refusal:

Ol The proposed roof extension would have an adverse effect on the appearance of the buildings and would be detrimental to the visual amenity of the Conservation Area by reason of bulk, design and location.

02 The proposed development would result in a total density in excess of that indicated as appropriate in the Greater London Development Plan, the Written Statement of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 1987 (the Borough Plan), and the draft Unitary Development Plan.

03 The proposal would be likely to exacerbate the existing parking problems

in the area.

04 The proposal would be likely to result in loss of or damage to existing trees on the site.
