Development:

Reasons for refusal (1) The proposal constitutes an excessive extension of an industrial use which does not accord with the Reasons for refusal Council's Development Plan in which this area is allocated for residential purpopes.

(2) The proposal could infringe the Council's standards as regards the daylighting of buildings where it abute on the gardens of houses in Gloucester Crescent.

(3) The proposal constitutes an undesirable extension of industry within the area and does not accord with the Council's policy of restricting the expansion of industry within the County. Yours faithfully,
