Gentlemen,

Town and Country Planning Act, 1933.

Consideration has been given to your application of 7th October, 1936, for permission under the Town and Country Planning (General Intervin Development) Order, 1933, to erect a Buddhist Temple on the site at the rear of 41, Gloucester Road, St. Pancras, in accordance with the plan 141207 (Registered No. 29197) submitted.

With reference thereto I am directed to inform you that the Council, in pursuance of its powers under the Order, hereby refuses permission in respect of your application on the grounds that:

- (1) the erection of a temple on the site is an inappropriate development thereof which would adversely affect the amenities of the surrounding property; and
- (2) even were the Council prepared to permit the development of the site in the manner proposed, the proposals submitted are unsatisfactory.
