I refer to your letter dated 26th April 1984 submitting details pursuant to conditions 3.4,5 & 6 of planning permission dated 15th June 1983 (Reg. no.34469(R3)) for the following:-

- (a) The conversion, alteration and extension to the rear of 1 & 2 Chester Gate to form offices.
- (b) The conversion and alteration of 5 & 4 Chester Gate to form one dwelling house, 2 maisonettes, 1 flat and 2 bedsitting room units.
