The use, at 33 Conway Street, St. Pancras, of the basement for storage and office purposes, and of the ground, first, second and third floors for office purposes.

Reasons for refusal

- (1) The proposed use is contrary to the provisions of the Council's Development Plan, wherein the area in which the premises are Reason than a structed is soned for residential purposes, and the proposal would thus tend to prevent the ultimate implementation of the Plan.
- (2) The proposal represents a substantial increase in office floor space in the Central Zone, which is contrary to the policy of the Council, as set out in Section 18 (vi) of the Written Statement to the 1955 Development Plan, wherein it is stated that the Council will resist any proposal which would increase congestion in the Central Zone.
