## TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, 1947.

### Refusal of permission to develop

The Council, in pursuance of its powers under the above mentioned Act and the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1950, hereby refuses to permit the development referred to in the undermentioned Schedule as shown on the plans submitted.

In accordance with the provisions of Article 5 of the Order, your attention is drawn to the Statement of Applicant's Rights endorsed hereon.

### SCHEDULE

Date of application: 2 March 1959.

Plans submitted No. 23396.

Development: The use of No. 10 Queen Alexandra Mansions, Judd Street, St. Pancras, for office purposes.

Reasons for refusal Such use would not accord with the provisions of the Administrative County of London Development Plan in which this area is allocated for residential purposes, and would be contrary to the provisions of Section 16 of the Written Statement of the Development Plan which states: "throughout the County, permission (temporary or permanent) will not, except in very special circumstances, be given for a change from residential use of any residential building which can still be used, with or without adaptation, for residential purposes of any kind".
