1. The development hereby permitted must be begun not later than the expiration of five years from the date on which this permission is granted.

Reason for Standard Condition:

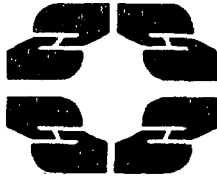
1. In order to comply with the provisions of Section 41 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971.

Additional Condition(s):

- 01 Noise from operations conducted on the premises shall not exceed 40dBA as measured at the boundaries of the site between the hours of 8am to 6pm on Mondays to Fridays and 1dBA above the background noise level at any other time.
- 02 The acoustic screen will be painted to match as closely as possible the existing colour of the building's brick work.

Reason(s) for Additional Condition(s):

- 01 & 02 To safeguard the amenities of the adjoining premises and the area generally.
