With reference to your application AR/TMD dated 22nd December, 1937, I am directed to inform you that the Council, in pursuance of its powers under the above-named Order, hereby permits the erection of an extension to a factory building at the premises known as Nos. 8-12, Verulam Street, Holborn, in accordance with plan No. 192580 (registered No. 43694) submitted subject to the Council's previous conditions of consent being otherwise complied with.

The permission is given in substitution for that conveyed to you in the Council's letter of consent dated 1st June, 1937, and is subject also to due compliance with any local Acts, regulations, building byelaws and general statutory provisions in force in the area and nothing herein shall be regarded as dispensing with such compliance or be deemed to be a consent by the Council thereunder.

I would also remind you that the Council's permission does not modify or affect any personal or restrictive covenants applying to the land or the rights of any person entitled to the benefit thereof.

This permission is in no way a consent to any work under the public way, which is a matter to be arranged between yourself and the Holborn Metropolitan Borough Council.
