

Following our meeting in Mr. Baldwin's office yesterday we enclose sets of prints in triplicate nos. SK 30/1 to 37/1 inclusive, incorporating amendments discussed then. These drawings supersede those numbered SK 15 to 23 inclusive accompanying our letter and TP 1 application dated the 31st March 1958, which drawings will you kindly discard.

In addition to the above we enclose two prints of our drawings nos. SK 30/1 and 31/1, being the ground floor and basement plans of the building, for consideration under the Restriction of Ribbon Development Act, 1935. These incorporate modifications to the layout of the ramp and cross-overs as discussed at the aforementioned meeting when Mr. Baguley was present, and they supersede those numbered SK 30 and 31 accompanying our letter of the 8th May, which will you now please discard.
