- 1. All new internal works and finishes and works of making good shall match existing original work adjacent in respect of materials used, detailed execution, and finished appearance except where indicated otherwise on the drawings hereby approved. (C27(b)
- 2. The new joinery work shall match exactly the materials, dimensions and profiles of existing original work, except where otherwise shown in the drawings hereby approved. (C27(e)
- 3. All existing ornamental features including chimney pieces, plasterwork, architraves, panelling, doors, and staircase balustrading shall remain undisturbed in their existing position and shall be fully protected during the course of works on site, unless specifically authorised otherwise on the drawings hereby approved. (C27(k)
- 4. All cornices and joinery affected by the alteration shall be made good to match the existing original.
- 5. No work shall start on site without prior written notification of that start to the London Division of the Historic Buildings and Monuments Commission, Chesham House, 30 Warwick Street, London, W1R 6AB quoting reference date 4 April 1990. ( $\underline{C27(n)}$ )
