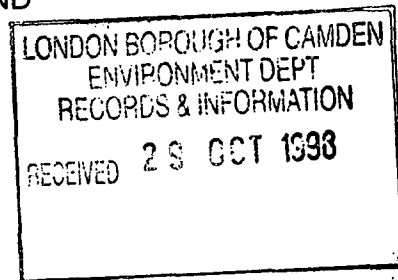

**APPLICATION FOR LISTED BUILDING CONSENT.**

We are applying for Listed Building consent for alterations to the above building which do not require planning consent.

1. In both 1.6 and 1.7 bathrooms we propose blanking the smaller opening light window with brickwork recessed on the outside. These windows face onto the alleyway and the blank flank wall of the adjoining owners' property. The bathroom layouts replace existing bathroom arrangements which were fitted out by the previous owner and are located in the extension wing to the main building.

2. The external drain run is proposed to enable drainage from the proposed bathroom and kitchen to be taken to an existing gully without undermining existing building footings, or breaking up of existing flagstones.

3. First floor R1.3; removal of modern cupboards C1.7(2no.) and C1.8 to return to original wall line and earlier panelling.
