Assessment

The proposal is simply to replace the existing ATM and internally illuminated surround and side panel. The purpose is to install an upgraded model with design features to increase usability for customers with sight impairment. The ATM, surround and side panel will be in exactly the same positions as the existing and will be of the same style. The base of the ATM will be approx 0.75m above pavement level with the top of the surround at approx 1.7m, the screen and control panel will be in the lower part of the display below 1.1m making it accessible to wheelchair users. The illumination will mostly be limited to the lettering apart from the strips on the side panel which will have the background illuminated.

The proposal would not alter the appearance of the host building as it is essentially a like for like replacement. The ATM is on a busy high street frontage with good visibility and in an area that is well lit at night and the location is therefore considered acceptable in community safety terms. The replacement of the ATM would have no negative impact on amenity and would increase the accessibility of the machine for less physically able users.

Recommendation:

The proposals are considered to be compliant with policies SD1, SD6, B1 and B4 of the replacement UDP 2006 and applications for advert consent and planning permission are therefore recommended for approval.

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
