The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

The proposed rear dormer, by reason of its size, bulk and design, would be detrimental to the appearance of the building and the character and appearance of the South Hill Park Conservation Area contrary to policies B1 (General design principles), B3 (Alterations and extensions) and B7 (Conservation areas) of the London Borough of Camden Replacement Unitary Development Plan 2006 and advice contained within the Council's Camden Planning Guidance 2006 and South



Hill Park Conservation Area Statement.

Informative(s):

1 You are advised that any proposal to create an additional habitable room in the roof space should have a minimum headroom of 2.3m over at least half of the floor area. Proposals that do not comply with this standard are likely to be unacceptable.

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
