The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

The proposed change of use to Class A2 would reduce the proportion of Class A1 units within the shopping frontage to below 75% to the detriment of the character, function, vitality and viability of the Camden Town Centre, contrary to policy R7A (Protection of shopping frontages and local shops - Central London Frontages, Town Centres and King's Cross) of the London Borough of Camden Replacement Unitary Development Plan 2006 and the Revised Planning Guidance for Camden
