Design Statement for the Listed Building Application

The British Museum is planning a season of two significant exhibitions exploring the nature of Imperial Power in the East and West, starting with the First Emperor China's Terracotta Army who established the Chinese Empire and followed by an exhibition on the Roman Emperor Hadrian under whose reign the Roman Empire reached its greatest extent. The exhibition season will last from September 2007 to October 2008.

The British Museum has received listed building consent to erect a temporary stage within the Round Reading room and a ticket desk in the South Eastern corner of the Great Court. London Borough of Camden reference number 2006/3731/L.

This application is for an additional retail desk in the Great Court which will be used only for merchandising exhibition related material. The retail desk will match the ticket desk in the South Eastern corner of the Great Court in the temporary stage application.

The retail desk will be entirely free standing and will therefore not be fixed to the fabric of the Great Court. The desks will be removed at the end of the exhibition season in October 2008. All power supplies and any cabling will be through existing openings and there will not be any need to form new openings in walls or floors.


